

If you've found a wasp nest near your home, the safest first move is to pause and evaluate the situation before anyone gets too close. In Brampton, where suburban homes often have soffits, eaves, decks, sheds, and fences that give wasps easy nesting spots, a small problem can become a fast-moving one.
