What you're aiming for is that this series:

1. You exhibit the strip.

- A unmarried sheet of paper (or cardstock once you need it stiffer)
- Scissors (small or medium, a specific thing you experience sure swinging)
- Double-sided tape or clear tape
- A pen or marker (for elective alignment marks)
- A organized gimmick strip you'll make formerly appearing (steps lower than)

Let's make the gimmick.

Build the prop: your "restorable" paper strip

Choose a paper shade that appears important beneath room lighting. White or brilliant shades paintings neatly on the grounds that the minimize line is apparent and the recovery pops. If you would like extra persona, upload a practical pattern or draw a border. Spectators remember that the "issue," no longer the technical element.

The precise series: cut, teach, restore

The temptation is to stay refining your gimmick unless it's invisible. That's no longer incorrect, however for inexperienced persons it will stall you. Instead, target for clarity first.

A brilliant first efficiency is one where:

- The spectator knows what component you narrow.
- The reduce moment seems decisive.
- The repair looks like it belongs inside the comparable motion, now not like a repair.
