If moisture readings are scattered across multiple areas and remain elevated in hidden spaces, the water may have traveled through your structure, raising contamination concern and labor costs.

Older homes with poor drainage or newer homes with complex layouts both need readings to map contamination spread. Drywall over 24% moisture for more than 72 hours invites mold colonization and requires replacement.
