

## Navigating Alcoholic Offerings Together With Age Limits for Grown-Up Gatherings

Alcohol and age-related restrictions can be one of the most complicated areas of planning an adult party.

Whether you're arranging a celebration for grown-ups, you need to factor in what's legally required, keeping guests safe, and guest expectations where alcohol is concerned.

What you need to know first is what the law says about alcohol in your area. In Malaysia, you must be 21 to drink legally. This is a legal mandate and must be followed.

If you have underage guests, you must not provide them alcohol—period.

## Guest Management and ID Checks

If you have a bar, you need to ensure that only people of legal age have access to drinks.

This means having a method for checking legal status at the entrance or the bar area. You can have the venue manage age verification if you're using a venue that serves alcohol.

If you're managing everything yourself, you might consider hiring a certified professional who can enforce the legal drinking age and [Kollysphere Events](#) serve drinks appropriately.

Or instead, you could use wristbands or markers to indicate legal-age attendees from younger guests.

## Controlled Consumption

Beyond the letter of the law, there's the question of duty of care. How you serve alcohol can shape the overall experience.

Helpful methods include providing alcohol-free beverages for guests who don't drink, transportation arrangements, food to absorb alcohol, and professionals who practice to cut people off when needed.



Evaluate having a cutoff time for alcohol service and moving to soft drinks only toward the end of the event to ensure safe departures.

Be aware that as the organizer, have the final duty of care for the safety of your guests. Be mindful of consumption and don't be afraid to intervene if you see someone who's had too much.
