- **Lack of Community Presence:** Check platforms like Trustpilot, Reddit (e.g., r/csgobet), and Twitter. If a site has an overwhelmingly negative track record or is completely unknown, it is best avoided.

Finest Practices for Safe Wagering

Even on the most legitimate platforms, accountable bankroll management and security health are essential. Follow these suggestions to make sure a safe experience:

- **Enable Steam Guard:** Always use the Steam Guard Mobile Authenticator. This adds a crucial layer of defense to your stock.
