We made 3 modifications. We multiplied the entry matting by eight ft with a heavyweight wiper, switched to a impartial purifier with chelating brokers, and reduce the restorer. We also lowered autoscrubber resolution pass by a 3rd and introduced a circulate devoid of resolution within the last 20 toes previously the elevators to go away the floor drier. Slip incidents dropped to at least one in two months. Complaints approximately scent vanished. The marble maintained a organic sheen without glare, and the danger manager moved floor care from the prime of her be anxious listing to the midsection.
