



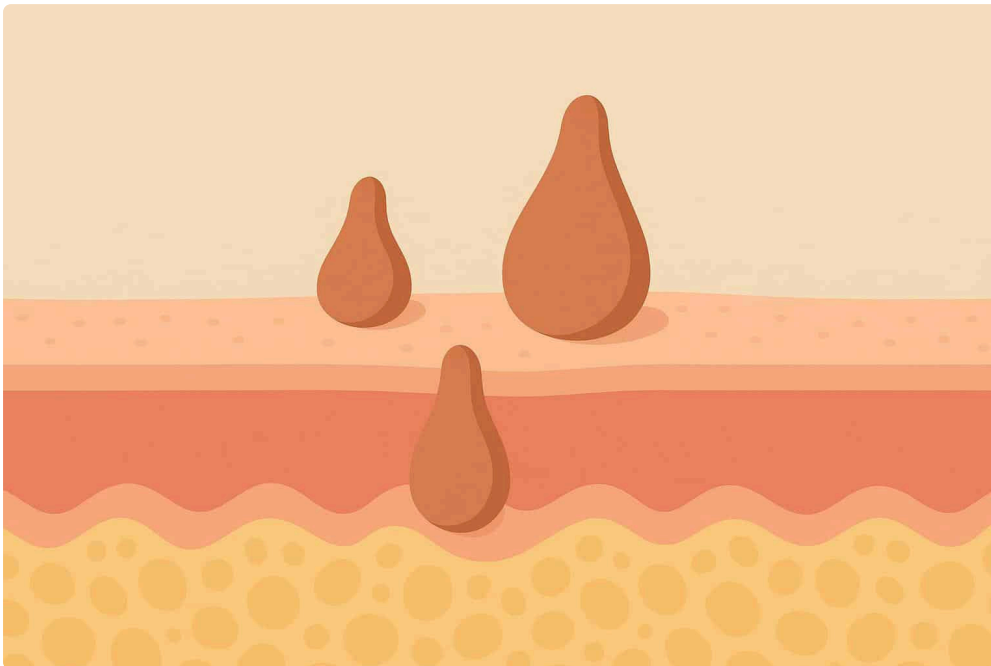
Acne Imposter - Milia
