Another purchaser, a pastry chef, insisted on factual marble. We built the island in honed Carrara, sealed it, and defined etching. She bakes day-to-day and loves the cool floor. After a 12 months, the island had faint etch rings that caught the light solely at precise angles. She calls it her map. We used a leathered black granite on the perimeter, and it stays essentially unchanged considering that installation. Her kitchen feels conventional and evidently used.
