- Widespread visible mold colonies.
- Deep penetration into porous materials.
- Health hazard; requires remediation.
- Materials are often unsalvageable.



#### Structural Damage & Cracks

- Foundation cracks or shifts.
- Compromised load-bearing elements.
- Severe and long-term exposure.
- Professional structural assessment needed.

## How Does Contamination Category Change What You Actually Pay to Repair Water Damage?

The contamination category of your water intrusion is the single largest cost driver in restoration. Clean water from a burst pipe (Category 1) requires drying and minor repairs.
