Understanding the Top Slot and Multipliers

Before every spin of the main wheel, a smaller sized two-reel fruit machine located directly above the wheel-- referred to as the **Top Slot**-- spins simultaneously.

- **How it works:** The Top Slot produces one random wheel segment (a number or a reward video game) and pairs it with a random multiplier ranging from 2x to 50x.
- **The Result:** If the primary wheel arrive on the precise section shown in the Top Slot, the multiplier is applied to that spin. If it is a number bet, the payout is multiplied. If it is a bonus offer video game, the multipliers within the bonus offer round are improved appropriately.

The Four Crazy Time Bonus Rounds

The piece de resistance of the game is its four perk rounds. Gamers who have actually placed a wager [crazy time free](#) on the specific benefit sector are granted entry into the mini-game when the wheel lands on it.

1. Coin Flip

3. Pachinko

- **Frequency:** 2 segments on the wheel.
- **Gameplay:** A glowing puck is dropped from the top of a huge Pachinko wall filled with pegs. The puck bounces down arbitrarily up until it lands in one of the slots at the bottom, each consisting of a multiplier. If the puck lands on a "DOUBLE," all multipliers on the board double, and the puck is dropped once again.

4. Crazy Time

- **Frequency:** Only 1 segment on the wheel.
- **Gameplay:** Players step behind a red door into a lively, surreal virtual world featuring a gigantic 64-segment wheel. The host selects one of 3 flappers (Green, Blue, or Yellow). The wheel spins, and whatever multiplier the selected flapper points to is granted. Like Pachinko, this wheel includes "DOUBLE" and "TRIPLE" segments, permitting multipliers to rise to a shocking 20,000 x.

Due To The Fact That Crazy Time is a video game of pure chance governed by a Random Number Generator (RNG) and physical physics, no method can guarantee a win. However, players can manage their bankrolls and optimize their gameplay by sticking to certain best practices.

- **Diversify Your Bets:** Placing small wagers throughout numerous numbers and perk rounds guarantees that you stay in the action longer and don't lose out when a bonus offer round hits.
- **Focus On the Bonus Rounds:** Statistically, your house edge on the number sectors (1, 2, 5, 10) is typically greater than the bonus rounds. Many experienced gamers select to put small bets specifically on the 4 bonus sections to chase the game's optimum payout capacity.
- **Set a Strict Budget:** The fast-paced nature of live video game shows can result in fast costs. Pick a fixed bankroll before you start playing and stick to it, despite wins or losses.
- **Do Not Chase Losses:** If you experience a cold streak where the wheel bypasses your bets, avoid the temptation to increase your stake sizes to recover lost funds quickly.
