

A reliable garage door safeguards vehicles, storage, and one of the largest openings in a home. For homeowners in the San Fernando Valley, a faulty door can also cause security, access, and safety concerns. Garage Door Repair Services in the San Fernando Valley

Failed Springs, Cables, and Rollers

Loud, Stuck, or Misaligned Overhead Doors

An **overhead garage door** that squeaks, rattles, binds, or stops partway may have degraded rollers, loose hinges, a bent **garage door track**, or inadequate lubrication. A garage door roller that is cracked or dragging can create loud operation and place additional stress on the opener.

Proper **garage door balance** is important. With professional precautions, a technician can determine whether the door stays near the intended position when disconnected from the opener. A door that falls, rises, or feels excessively heavy may have a spring or counterbalance problem. Tracks should be checked for alignment and secure mounting, but they should not be pounded or forced into position without identifying the cause of the misalignment.

Heat in the Valley can dehydrate or harden certain oils and seals. Dust, grit, and fine debris can also collect around moving parts. Routine garage door maintenance, including removing buildup and proper lubrication, may lessen noise, but lubricant cannot resolve a bent track, failing bearing, damaged roller, or unbalanced door.

Garage Door Opener and Remote Problems

A garage door opener may fail because of a deteriorated drive mechanism, stripped gear, faulty circuit board, dead remote battery, damaged wiring, or an obstruction near the photo-eye sensor. The photo-eye sensors should be directed at each other and remain clean and properly aligned. If the opener light flashes but the door will not close, sensor alignment is one possible cause.

Garage door opener repair may be reasonable when [Garage Door Opener](#) the unit is otherwise reliable and replacement parts are available. Replacement may make more sense when the opener is old, unusually loud, lacks modern safety features, or has repeated electrical failures. A smart garage door opener can add app control, activity alerts, and compatibility with some home automation systems, but it still requires correctly adjusted door hardware.

Learn how to use the emergency release only when necessary and only when the door is fully closed or safely supported. Pulling the release while a door is open can allow an unbalanced door to fall. A garage door spring contains considerable stored energy, so spring adjustment and replacement should be left to a qualified professional.

Regular garage door maintenance can include visual checks for frayed cables, loose fasteners, cracked rollers, worn seals, rust, and unusual movement. A garage door safety inspection is advisable after a vehicle impact, storm, attempted break-in, or significant change in operation. Valley sun and heat can also make seals brittle and finishes fade faster, so inspect those components each season.
