3. Prisma 2 Case

For gamers going after vibrant, anime-inspired, or lively sci-fi looks, the **Prisma 2 Case** is a top competitor.

- **Standout Skins:** M4A1-S|Gamer Two, AK-47|Phantom Disruptor.
- **Why it's excellent:** The M4A1-S|Gamer Two is a fan-favorite amongst players who choose lively, vibrant styles over military-sim visual appeals. Coupled with Horizon-series knives, it offers an excellent balance of price and visual appeal.

4. Operation Broken Fang Case

Operations constantly present iconic cases, and **Broken Fang** stands out due to its inclusion of agent skins (at the time) and high-demand weapon surfaces.

- **Standout Skins:** M4A4|Cyber Security, AWP|Exoskeleton.
- **Why it's excellent:** This case features the specialized glove swimming pool instead of basic knives. Gloves like Driver Gloves|Snow Leopard and Specialist Gloves|Marble Fade stay a few of the most sought-after products in the game, keeping the worth of this case progressively climbing up.

5. CS20 Case

Launched to commemorate the 20th anniversary of the Counter-Strike franchise, the **CS20 Case** relies greatly on nostalgia while presenting a brand-new knife type.

- **Standout Skins:** AWP|Wildfire, FAMAS|Ceremony.
- **Why it's terrific:** The introduction of the *Classic Knife* (a nod to the initial Counter-Strike 1.6 knife) makes opening this case a classic experience. The weapon skins pay homage to traditional map styles, making them immediate classics for veteran players.
