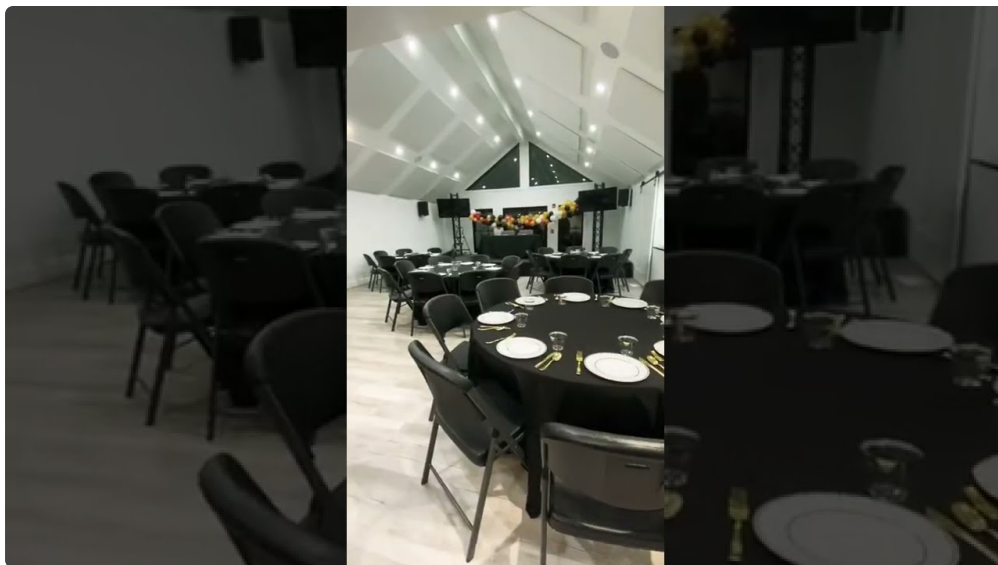

The Engineering Layer

AV and structural engineering support : For events requiring motorised moving pieces , additional charges [event company in Asia with best team to work with for brands and businesses](#) apply.
