- For a shed crown that is undamaged, tidy and dry the within, then use short-lived dental concrete to reseat it till you can get a correct recementation. Avoid superglue, which damages tooth framework and soft tissue.

- For recurring bleeding, apply firm pressure with clean gauze or a wet tea bag for 20 mins without glancing. If hemorrhaging continues or you take blood thinners, get in touch with a dental professional or immediate care.

Pain control and anti-biotics, made use of wisely

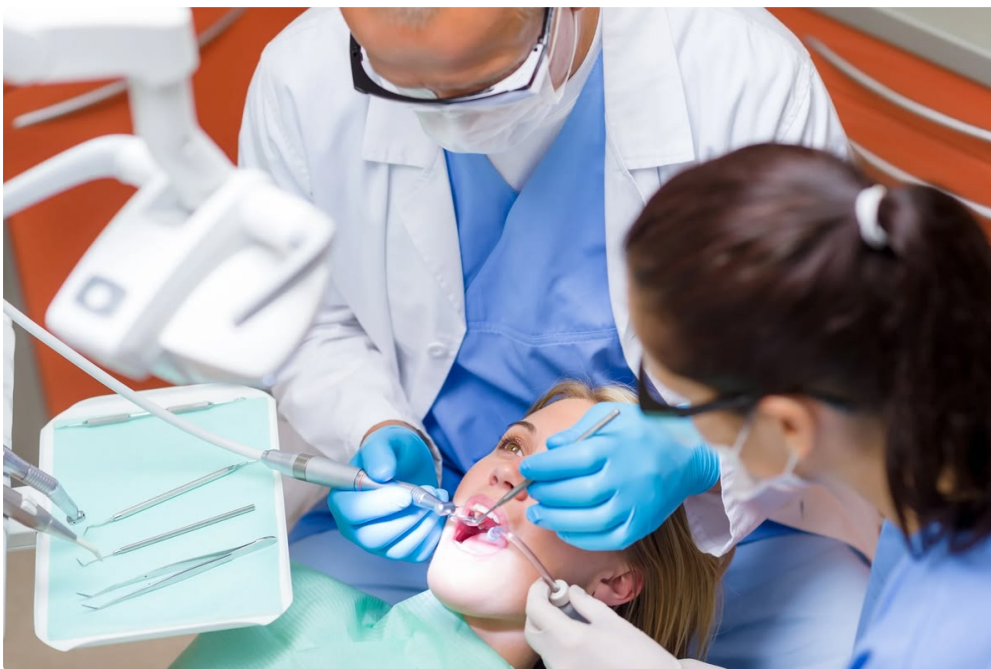
