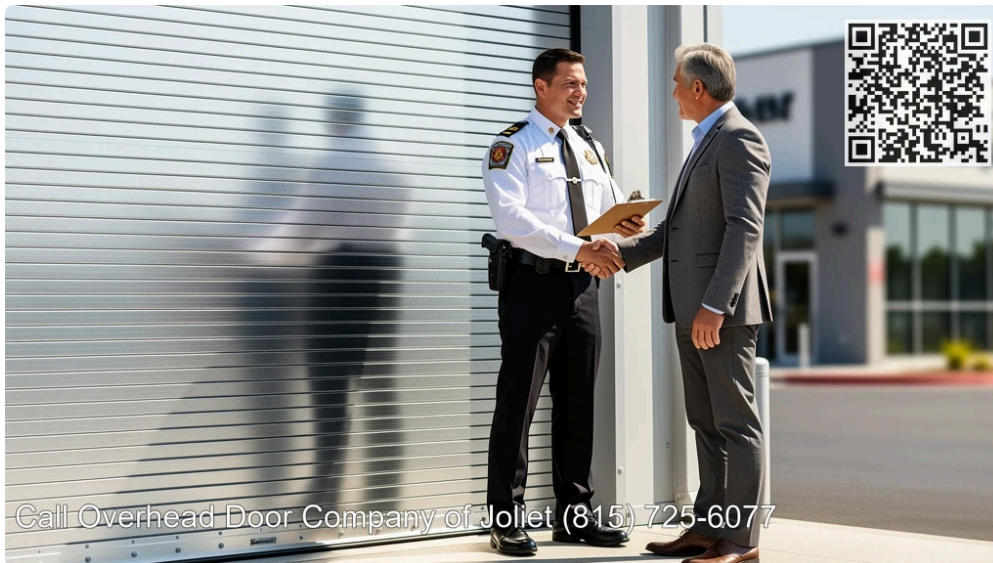

A distribution center near the river was running a 20 foot vast roll-up dividing its hazmat storage from basic hosting. The existing door was old enough that no one had the design number. The governor was inconsistent, and the annual drop examination took the better part of a morning. The insurance coverage provider flagged it, and the facility supervisor lastly had cover to get it fixed.

We replaced the assembly with a FireKing rated moving service door sized for the block opening. The coil fit under a lawn sprinkler primary by a scant two inches, validated with a completely dry run before we reduced supports. 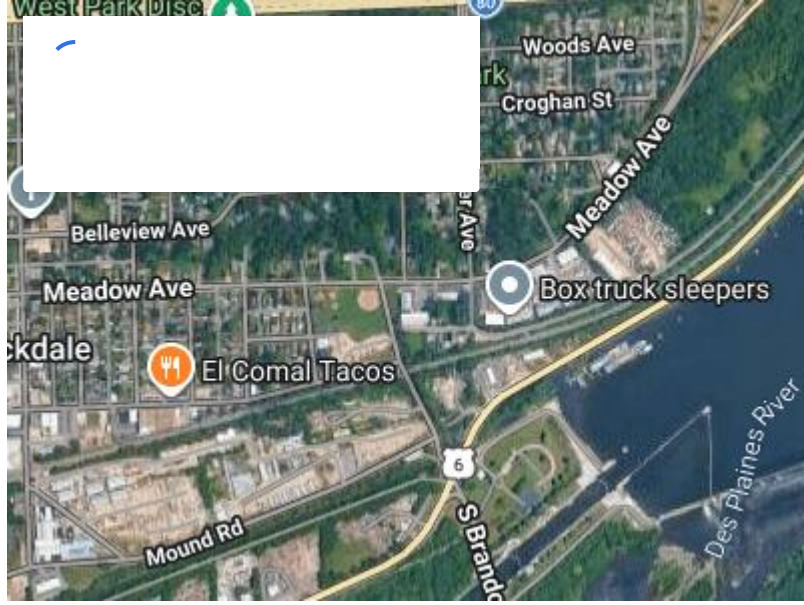
