Why Does System Size Change Everything About Your Daily Operating Costs?

That repeated starting burns fuel and creates wear on components. A correctly sized system completes its cycles and reaches your target temperature without the energy-draining restarts.

How Does Incorrect Sizing Push You Toward Running AC All Day Long?

Homeowners with oversized units often feel frustrated because the system cools too fast, then the house warms back up quickly. This pattern makes people think they should just leave the AC running all day to maintain comfort. In reality, they are fighting a sizing problem, not a runtime problem. An undersized unit, on the other hand, cannot keep up on Sacramento's hottest days, so owners also run it continuously in desperation. Either way, wrong sizing forces continuous operation.

What Questions Should You Ask About Your System's Original Sizing?

When Sacramento Precision HVAC Repair diagnoses your cooling costs, we start by asking whether your system was sized using a Manual J load calculation. This is the industry standard, and it is the only way to determine correct capacity. Many older installations were guessed or sized according to a rule of thumb. If your installer did not perform a load calculation, your system is almost certainly wrong for your home.

Ask your service technician whether your unit's tonnage—measured in BTUs—matches your home's actual cooling demand. We can tell you in minutes whether your system is oversized, undersized, or right-sized. If it is oversized, you now have a reason to stop feeling guilty about turning it off during mild shoulder seasons. If it is

How Right Sizing Determines Your Realistic Operating Schedule

Once you have the correct size, you can confidently turn your system off at night or during cooler mornings without losing cooling performance during the heat of the day. A properly sized unit responds quickly to demand and reaches your thermostat setting within a predictable timeframe. You are not waiting or compensating.
