3.3. Understand Odds and Expected Value

The expected worth (EV) of a bet represents the average quantity a player can expect to win or lose per unit wagered. For a 50/50 coin flip, the EV is 0 (no home edge). For roulette, the presence of the green "0" pocket creates an unfavorable EV for the player.

When examining a bet, ask:

- What is the payout relative to the true likelihood?
- Does the website take a commission (rake) that even more wears down EV?

By consistently favoring bets with an EV near to absolutely no (or favorable, when skill-based), the player reduces the long-term benefit of your home.

3.4. Leverage Skill-Based Wagering
