

How Burbank Weather Affects Garage Doors

Burbank, California lies in the San Fernando Valley, where the Los Angeles climate brings warm, arid summers, strong sunlight, changing temperatures, and mild winters with seasonal rainfall. These conditions are generally pleasant for homeowners, but they can gradually affect an overhead garage door, its components, and its powered operating mechanism.

A garage door is vulnerable to the elements daily. Sunlight can discolor and degrade exterior finishes, while heat can dry out seals and limit the effectiveness of lubricants. During the wet season, water may accumulate near the garage threshold or enter through worn weatherstripping. Preventive maintenance and timely garage door repair help prevent these problems before they affect security, convenience, or safety.

Hot Weather, Sunlight, and Door Components

Burbank's sweltering, arid summers create temperature extremes that are especially tough on garage door materials facing south or west. Powerful UV exposure can cause color fading, cracking, and increased brittleness in a garage door panel, bottom seal, and perimeter weatherstripping. Prolonged sunlight can impact the garage door opener as well. Inspect seals for spaces, hardening, and noticeable fractures before summer begins. Keeping the door balanced reduces stress on the opener and spring system during the summer heat.

Winter Rain, Moisture, and Corrosion Risks

Water may get in through worn weatherstripping, an irregular threshold, or obstructed drainage around the driveway. Moisture left on metal hardware can cause rust and corrosion, especially on exposed fasteners, rollers, garage door springs, and garage door tracks.

Before the rainy season, check that water drains away from the garage and that the bottom seal makes continuous contact with the floor. Replacing damaged weatherstripping is often a simple way to improve moisture protection and reduce drafts.

Typical Garage Door Problems in Burbank Homes
