Build for distance and noise, no longer just for camera

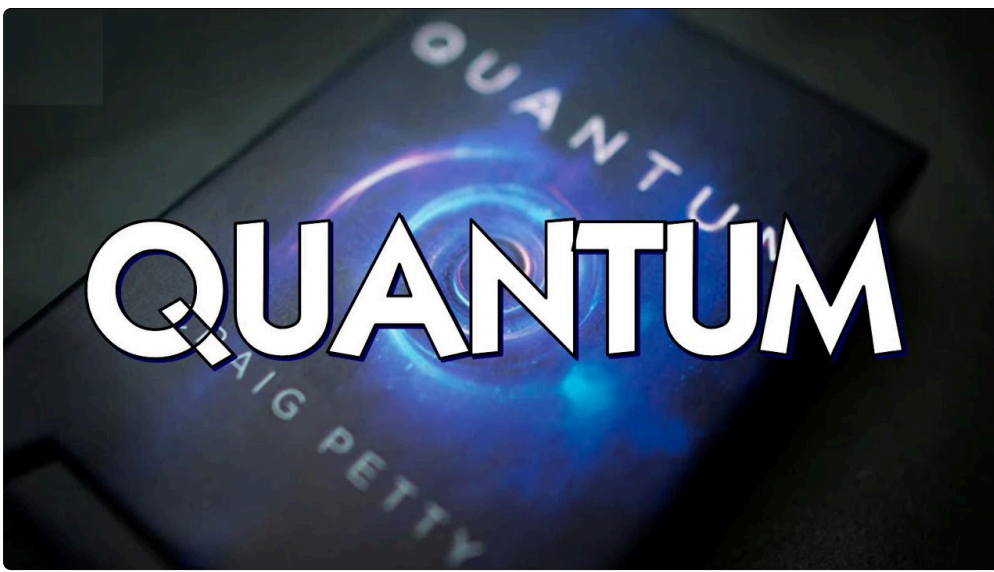
