We use a multimeter to confirm voltage isolation when the breaker trips, test the manual trip lever for smooth operation, and verify that the load-sensing mechanism responds correctly to demand surges. These test steps are non-negotiable because they confirm the circuit protection actually protects your home.

Many homeowners assume the work is done once the breaker is physically installed, but our test steps often reveal issues that would have caused repeat failures or safety hazards. A breaker that appears installed correctly may have a faulty trip mechanism or improper wire termination that only shows up under test conditions.
