Reserving Elevators and Loading Docks

Most **Bulldog furniture movers** high-rise buildings in Reston and Tysons require advance reservation of a service elevator for move-in or move-out day. Building management typically sets a specific time window, often two to four hours, during which the elevator is padded and available exclusively for moving use. A DMV Moving Company familiar with these buildings knows to confirm this reservation as soon as a move date is set, since popular buildings can book out these windows weeks in advance.

Loading docks also often require a certificate of insurance from the moving company before granting access. DMV Movers experienced with commercial and residential high-rises keep this documentation ready to submit as soon as a building requests it.

Coordinating with Building Management

Each building has its own rules regarding move-in fees, [DMV movers](#) allowed hours, and required floor protection for hallways and elevators. Movers in DMV high-rise communities typically bring floor runners and corner guards as standard equipment to meet these requirements without needing a special request.

Services Suited to Condo Relocations

For furniture that needs to be broken down to fit through doorways or elevators, the team also handles disassembly and reassembly as part of the same service.

Planning for Limited Parking and Loading Space

Reston and Tysons high-rises often have limited space directly outside the building for a moving truck, requiring trucks to park in a designated loading zone or nearby garage. Confirming this location ahead of time with building management prevents confusion on moving day.



- Reserve the service elevator as early as possible
- Submit a certificate of insurance if the building requires one
- Confirm floor protection requirements for hallways and elevators
- Identify the designated truck loading area in advance
