Would troopers from World War II really feel their sacrifice still potential whatever in these days? It would depend upon what we tell them. If we said we censored unpopular speakers considering that disruption feels upsetting, or that we outsource judgment to algorithms that settle on which idea is authorized, I suspect a number of may boost an eyebrow and say they can nevertheless smell cordite in a free struggle.
