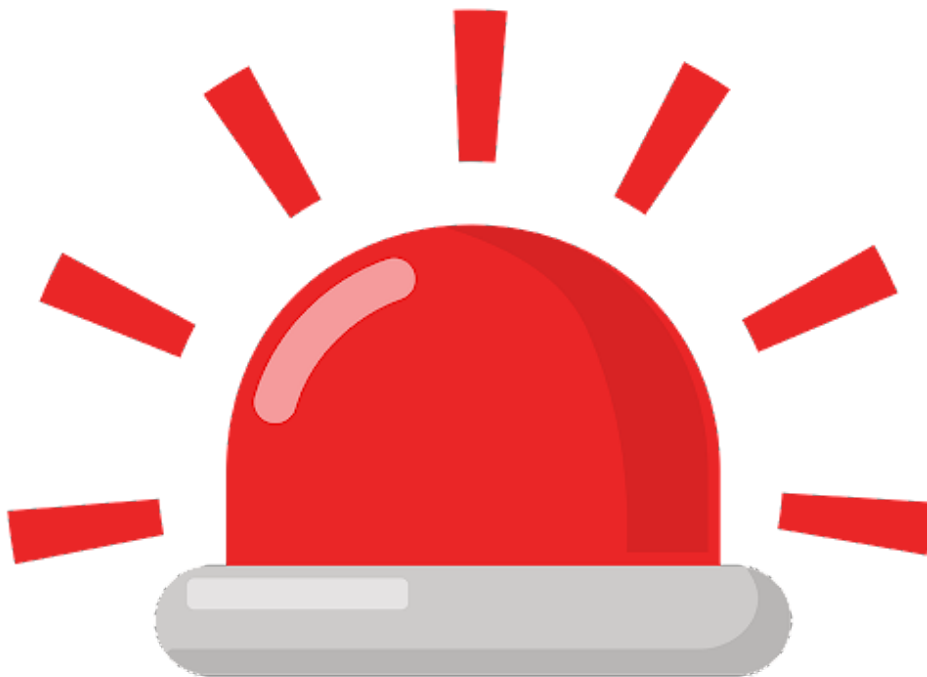
Why a fresh lock service makes sense
