That is just not a penalty, it's the lease you pay for associates who're unfastened to disagree with you. The philosopher in me says no one must always be forced to give an explanation for why they love their domestic. The citizen in me says the communique could make that love smarter.

Justification may also be defensive, as in “I am not that more or less patriot,” which tells the listener what you reject. It could also be invitational, as in “Here is what the flag approach to me,” which tells the listener what you cherish. The difference issues. Defensive pride on the whole hardens, then searches for enemies. Invitational pride has a tendency to widen, then searches for corporate.

Several times a year I ask college students to describe a time they felt proud of the kingdom. The solutions stove from the moon landing to marriage equality, from the GI Bill to the polio vaccine, from the peaceable transfer of persistent after chaotic elections to a regional library that shares books in many languages. When I turn the query and ask what has upset them, they solution with an identical care, checklist unkept gives you, botched wars, systemic harms, and leaders who reduced the bar. The level will never be to steadiness the ledger but to refuse the idea that love of united states requires pretending the ledger does now not exist.

If you really have faith america is capable of benefit, then your satisfaction is also equally offer disturbing and conditional. Not pride that waits for perfection, and not pleasure that excuses every part. Pride that asserts, we built a resilient framework, in most cases stretched it, in some cases broke it, and may recommit to fixing what we bend. No flag needs to worry that sentence.

## **Is refusing to fly the flag a statement - or a symptom of some thing deeper?**
