

When a door lock begins sticking, wobbling, or failing after a key turn, the problem is usually less about convenience than about whether the door still protects the people and property behind it. How local lock repair is handled in Orlando

look for wear around the strike area. Those distinctions save property owners from replacing parts that were never the true cause.

If the fragment has scarred the cylinder, then the repair may need to move toward replacement.
