Mid-century cattle ranch homes socialize copper, galvanized steel, and the occasional mystery PVC. Cellars tease with the groundwater level after a hard rainfall. Throw in fully grown tree origins and the clay soil along the Potomac, and you get an ideal recipe for slow drains, reoccurring obstructions, and backed-up drains.
