We shifted to a satin black backer panel with a decent two inch border, floated off the stone by three quarters of an inch. The stainless letters fixed to the panel with easy, even halo lighting around their edges, and the black field saved legibility mighty. The customer kept the stone, which they liked, and won a signal that looked motive built rather than compelled.

At a tech startup, the lobby was once compact, with a glass front and direct sun inside the morning. They needed illuminated channel letters within the company's cool blue. Under daylight, the face lit letters would have washed out, and the LEDs might be visual as dots. We recommended dimensional acrylic letters with an aluminum face, area lit from a backer frame to create a crisp blue ring at night and a reliable metal learn via day. In a healthcare placing, cleaning protocols count. We refrained from porous woods and frustrating seams, determining painted acrylic with radiused edges on a seamless backer. We hooked up every thing with hidden hardware and used a satin finish that resists streaking. The amenities group preferred that the every day wipe down took seconds and left no water marks.

Coordinating with broader industrial signage
