A pale hand-sanding with maroon pads or 220-grit paper scuffs the surface, but raised grain and open cease-grain on MDF need more thoughtful handling. Topcoat application is a rhythm. We examine viscosity, stress the paint, test on a sample door, then spray skinny, even passes with best suited overlap. We watch edges for vacation trips and profiles for sags. Once a coat tacks, we set items on drying racks with foam aspects to restrict imprinting. Recoat windows are non-negotiable. If a

product demands a recoat between 2 and six hours, we do not wait unless hour 10 without a mild scuff. That area is what maintains blockading and print-by way of at bay.

## Color, sheen, and design decisions

Hardware holes had been crammed and re-drilled to modify from 3-inch pulls to 5-inch, which required a jig and patience to prevent strains instantly.

From arrival to closing wipe-down took eight running days. At day three after rehang, the finish felt dry but we still prompt soft use for a few weeks. Six months later the client generally known as, not with a grievance, however to schedule ceiling portray products and services within the adjacent family room considering the fact that the shelves made the historic ceiling glance worn out. That is the ripple outcomes a nicely-achieved cupboard end has on a dwelling house.
