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Walk through any Arlington community in April and you see the very same story on a great deal of houses: green movie creeping up siding, dark stripes on gutters, streaks on the driveway, and brick actions that get slick after a rain. The mix of humidity, tree cover, pollen, and roadway salt in Northern Virginia is rough on outside surface areas. A great professional can make a residential or commercial property look five years more youthful in an afternoon. Second, whether they ask about previous water invasion problems or current window replacements. Third, whether they point out cleaning the underside of gutters and soffits, which often hold the most visible staining.

On older brick rowhouses or painted masonry near Lyon Village or Aurora Highlands, an experienced pro will call the pressure method down and focus on chemistry and dwell time. High pressure on old mortar can accelerate crumbling and leave wand marks that end up being apparent once the wall dries.

Roof washing

Roof cleaning is where the space in between professionals and "guy with a machine" ends up being stark.

Asphalt shingle roofs with black streaks are exceptionally typical in Arlington. Those streaks are generally a kind of algae called *Gloeocapsa lava*. The appropriate method to resolve them is a soft wash utilizing a very low-pressure application of a solution mainly based upon salt hypochlorite (similar to family bleach, but more powerful and thoroughly combined), plus surfactants, followed by a thorough rinse where appropriate.
