Under the Uniformed Services Former Spouses' Protection Act, state courts are authorized to treat military retired pay as property subject to division in a divorce. The division is accomplished through a court order that is later certified and honored by the Defense Finance and Accounting Service, and the specific terms of the order must comply with federal requirements. Deployment and geographic separation create procedural complications in military divorce cases, including questions about whether Virginia has jurisdiction over both parties when one spouse is stationed elsewhere, whether the Servicemembers Civil Relief Act allows a postponement of proceedings, and how parenting plans should be structured to accommodate training schedules, temporary duty assignments, and the possibility of deployment.
