Most importantly, they're essential for keeping neighbors attached, yet separate.

- A Party Wall Notice is a paper informing you that your neighbor(s) are proposing on executing jobs which drop within the Celebration Wall Surface Act.
- You will now have a few alternatives to select from within that notice in regards to what you desire to do, I.E. do you wish to use an Event Wall Property Surveyor or otherwise?
- The Celebration Wall Honor is formulated by either one Property surveyor who would be serving as the Agreed Land surveyor or 2 Surveyors if the neighbor(s) desire to use their own surveyor.

- If your next-door neighbor can't pay for timely repair work or upkeep, it can bring about further damages and rise costs for everybody included.
