Old Age

Though it is rare, this can result in angiosarcoma (a form of cancer) but more often leads to the formation of a harmless bundle known as angioma. Consequently, patients may notice the first appearance of these skin lesions in their mid to late 30s.

Chemicals

Certain chemicals may contribute to the development of angioma. These chemicals include mustards gas, bromides and cyclosporine containing chemical compounds. Bromide poisoning presents a higher risk in the sprouting of cherry angioma.

Hormonal Imbalance and Other Factors

Hormonal imbalances that commonly occur during pregnancy have been linked to cherry angioma. These imbalances could also result from bromide poisoning caused by food additives and other pesticides.
