The Theme or Vibe

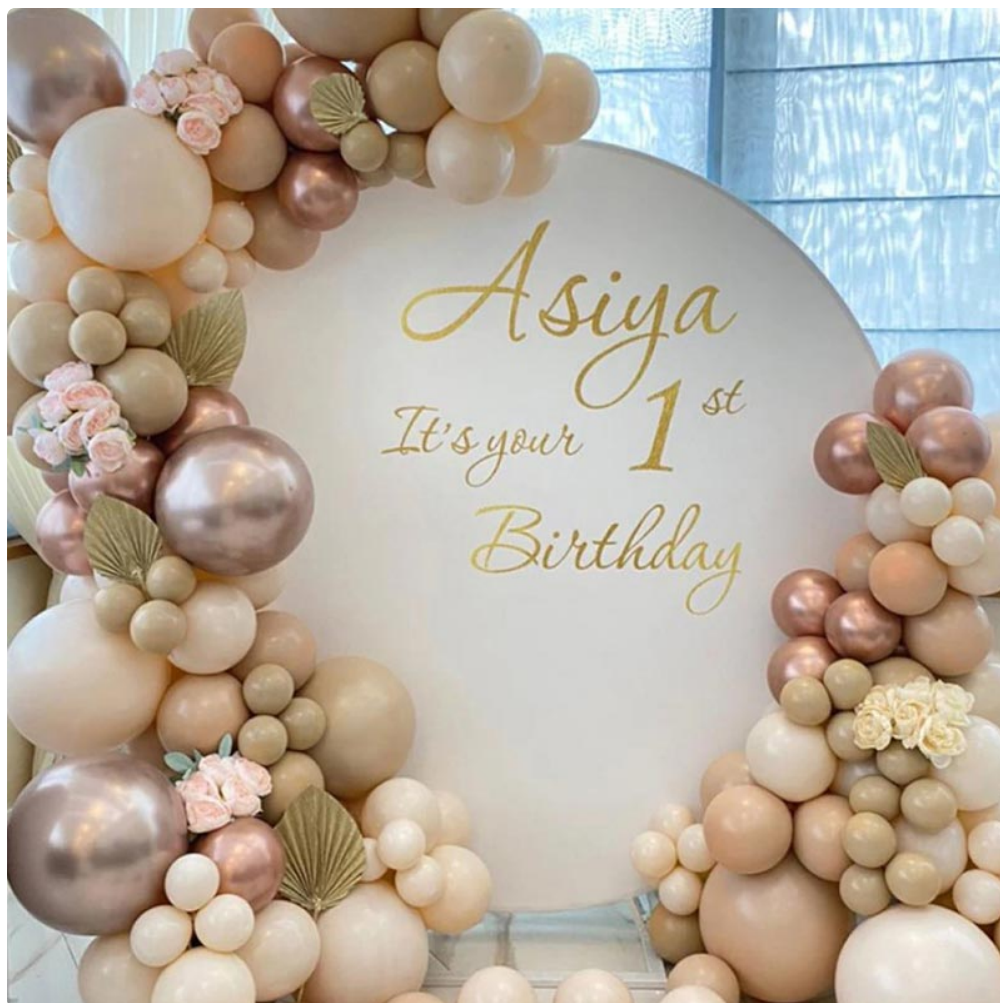
