Idea: Look for platforms that publish a "provably fair" hash for each battle. This enables players to individually verify that the outcome was not altered after the truth.

4. Kinds Of Case Battle Giveaways

- **Scheduled Giveaways**-- Occur at a fixed time every day (e.g., 8 PM UTC). Gamers should sign up before the start.
- **Instantaneous Giveaways**-- Randomly activated after any case battle concludes; winners are drawn quickly from the pool of participants.
