Popular Aviator Strategies and Tactics

Since Aviator counts on an RNG, no strategy can guarantee a win. Nevertheless, experienced gamers use specific risk-management approaches to maximize their bankroll and lengthen their gameplay.

- **The Low-Risk/ Conservative Strategy:**

- *How it works:* Players set up Auto Cash Out at low multipliers, such as 1.20 x to 1.50 x, and location smaller bets.
- *Objective:* To accomplish frequent, little wins that steadily develop the bankroll. The disadvantage is that a single unanticipated 1.00 x crash (where the aircraft flies away right away) can eliminate numerous previous gains.

- **The Dual-Bet Strategy:**

- *How it works:* Players put 2 bets simultaneously. The first bet is set to auto-cash out at a moderate multiplier (e.g., 2.00 x) to secure a profit or break even. The 2nd bet is delegated run by hand for a greater, riskier multiplier (e.g., 10x or greater).
- *Objective:* Balancing safety with the excitement of chasing after an enormous payment.
