Sealing as soon as a yr saved stains in money. After two years, minor knife marks lived close the prep quarter, barely seen inside the honed texture, normal as part of the home's rhythm.

A compact rental where area mattered more than present. We specified good floor in a delicate white, integrated sink, and a tight coved backsplash. Every joint disappeared.
