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What Is Alignment Repair for Garage Doors?

Garage door alignment repair adjusts the position and motion of an overhead garage door so it moves evenly through the garage door tracks. The tracks guide the door's rollers as the panels go up and down. If the tracks, rollers, hinges, panels, or lifting system are improperly positioned, the door may drag, stick, lean, or stop before reaching the floor.

Proper garage door alignment is essential for proper function and balanced weight distribution. A small adjustment may involve adjusting hardware, repositioning a track, or lubricating and replacing damaged garage door rollers.
