Other typical issues include frayed cables, loose hardware, failed remote controls, damaged weather stripping, and opener motor problems. A professional diagnosis should find the underlying cause rather than simply replacing the easiest to see part.

Why Will Not My Garage Door Open or Close?

If your garage door won't open, first check whether the garage door opener has power. Inspect the outlet, circuit breaker, wall button, and remote control batteries. **door opener repair** If the opener runs noisily but the door does not move, the drive mechanism, trolley, gear, or spring system may need repair.

A garage door won't close safely when the photo-eye sensor is blocked, dirty, or misaligned. These small sensors sit near the bottom of the tracks and must face each other properly. Clean their lenses with a soft, dry cloth and move objects, leaves, or storage containers from the doorway.

If the opener runs but the door reverses, inspect the photo-eye sensor lights and check for track obstructions. Do not force the door downward.
