

A malfunctioning garage door can interfere with everyday activities, home security, and vehicle access. A noisy garage door may have worn rollers, loose hinges, dry bearings, or a track that needs adjustment. Squealing, grinding, and popping sounds should not be disregarded. Worn rollers can create vibration and place additional stress on the opener. Lubrication may help appropriate metal moving parts, but it will not correct a bent track or a failing spring.

A misaligned door often signals uneven tension, a damaged cable, a broken spring, or garage door alignment concerns. The door may move upward on one side, sag at the center, or bind in the tracks.
