Note: The precise possibility for a particular knife (e.g., Karambit|Fade) is a portion of the rare special item pool.

These numbers illustrate that the overwhelming majority of openings will produce standard skins, not knives. The low probability makes knife openings a high-risk, high-reward activity.

Tips for Responsible Knife Opening

- Set a Budget**-- Decide in advance just how much you are willing to invest. Deal with the cash as home entertainment cost, not a financial investment.
- Comprehend the Odds**-- Recognize that the huge bulk of openings will not yield a knife. The anticipated return is negative.
- Avoid Chasing Losses**-- If a player spends a predetermined budget plan without getting a knife, it is recommended to stop instead of attempt to "win back" losses.
- Think about Trading**-- Once a knife is gotten, gamers can hold onto it hoping for future cost appreciation or trade it right away for other products or cash.
