Measure appropriately, not "close enough"

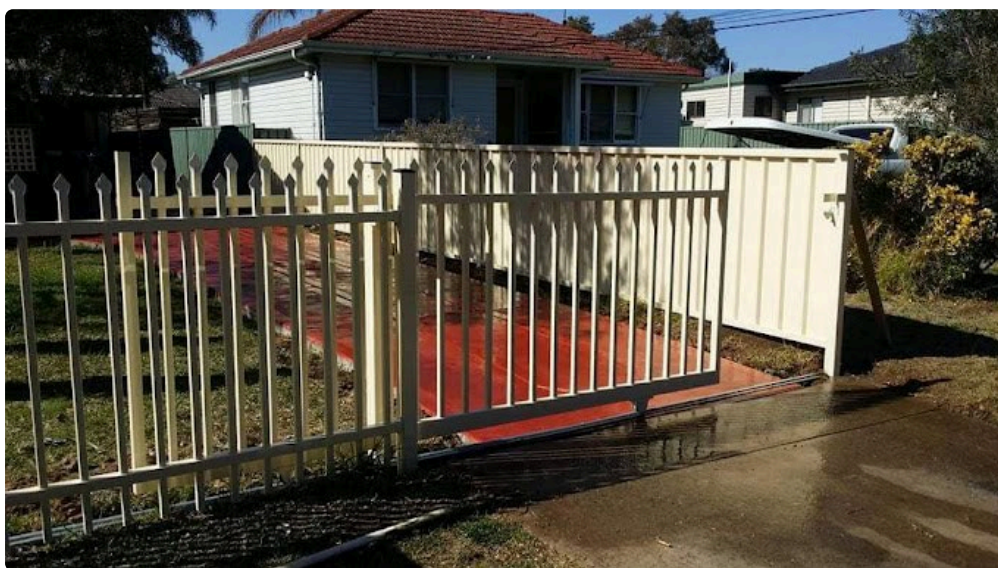
