2. Recoil Case

For gamers chasing after colorful, anime-inspired, or lively sci-fi aesthetics, the **Prisma 2 Case** is a top contender.



- **Standout Skins:** M4A1-S|Gamer Two, AK-47|Phantom Disruptor.
- **Why it's terrific:** The M4A1-S|Player Two is a fan-favorite amongst gamers who prefer spirited, lively designs over military-sim aesthetic appeals. Coupled with Horizon-series knives, it provides a terrific balance of affordability and visual appeal.

4. Operation Broken Fang Case

Operations always introduce iconic cases, and **Broken Fang** sticks out due to its inclusion of agent skins (at the time) and high-demand weapon surfaces.

- **Standout Skins:** M4A4|Cyber Security, AWP|Exoskeleton.
- **Why it's excellent:** This case features the specialized glove pool rather of basic knives. Gloves like Driver Gloves|Snow Leopard and Specialist Gloves|Marble Fade stay a few of the most sought-after products in the game, keeping the worth of this case steadily climbing up.

5. CS20 Case

Released to celebrate the 20th anniversary of the Counter-Strike franchise, the **CS20 Case** relies heavily on fond memories while introducing a new knife type.

- **Standout Skins:** AWP|Wildfire, FAMAS|Commemoration.
- **Why it's excellent:** The introduction of the *Classic Knife* (a nod to the initial Counter-Strike 1.6 knife) makes opening this case a sentimental experience. The weapon skins admire traditional map styles, making them instant classics for veteran players.
