- **Primitive Tier:** Bows, crossbows, machetes, and waterpipe shotguns. Highly effective in the early hours of a clean.
- **Mid Tier:** Custom SMGs, Thompson submachine guns, and semi-automatic rifles (SARs). These are the workhorses of mid-game PvP and monument raiding.
- **Endgame Tier:** Assault Rifles (LR-300 and AK), Bolt Action Rifles, and M92 Pistols, matched with heavy Metal Armor sets.

Quick Reference: Top-Tier Weapon Statistics

For gamers seeking to optimize their loadouts for PvP encounters, comprehending weapon stats is vital. Below is a relative table of a few of the most popular firearms in *Rust*.

2. **Bring it Home Safely:** Transport the item to base without getting ambushed by rival gamers.
3. **Research study:** Place the item on a Research Table together with the needed quantity of **Scrap** to discover its blueprint permanently.
4. **Unlock via Tech Tree:** Alternatively, gamers can invest scrap directly on a Workbench Tech Tree to unlock items sequentially without needing the physical item first.
