Higher pressures can drive water into joints and lift the grain, this means that greater sanding and a longer dry down.

For mold, treat with a solution like minded with the substrate. Sodium hypochlorite blended with water, plus a surfactant, handles organic and natural boom on wood and vinyl. Rinse competently. For metal, degreasers put off oils from palms and installs. Rinse and dry earlier you most desirable.

Sanding feathers edges the place ancient coatings remain.
