What is Crazy Time?

At its core, Crazy Time is a live casino game built around a giant, vertical 52-segment wheel. The video game is hosted by a live, energetic presenter who spins the wheel, interacts with the audience through live chat, and guides gamers through the various sections.

What sets Crazy Time apart from basic wheel games (like *Dream Catcher*) is the inclusion of a top slot positioned straight above the primary wheel. With every spin, the leading slot spins concurrently, [crazy time casino game](#) creating a random multiplier for a particular bet area. If the wheel stops on that spot and a benefit or number is multiplied, gamers can win astronomical payments.

Understanding the Wheel Segments

The 52 sections on the Crazy Time wheel are divided into numbers (which pay out basic money rewards) and reward rounds (which set off minigames). Comprehending the circulation of these sectors is essential for handling bankrolls and comprehending the video game's volatility.

The Number Bets

Players can put bets on four various numbers: **1, 2, 5, and 10**. Each number represents its payment multiplier if the wheel arrive on it.

- **1:** Appears 21 times on the wheel (highest frequency, least expensive payout of 1:1).
- **2:** Appears 13 times on the wheel (payout of 2:1).
- **5:** Appears 7 times on the wheel (payment of 5:1).
- **10:** Appears 4 times on the wheel (payout of 10:1).

The Bonus Rounds

The real excitement of Crazy Time lies in its four bonus offer rounds. These occupy a combined total of 9 sectors on the wheel, making them rarer to strike, but greatly more rewarding.

1. **Coin Flip** (4 segments on the wheel)
2. **Pachinko** (2 sectors on the wheel)
3. **Cash Hunt** (2 segments on the wheel)
4. **Crazy Time** (1 sector on the wheel)

The Four Thrilling Bonus Rounds Explained

When the wheel stops on a bonus sector, all players who placed a bet on that particular reward round are carried to a different, immersive set (or enhanced reality screen) to take part.

1. Coin Flip

The most basic of the reward rounds, Coin Flip includes a coin with a Red side and a Blue side. Each side is appointed a random multiplier by the video game system before the flip. The host pulls a lever to turn the coin, and whichever side lands face up awards the gamer that corresponding multiplier. If multipliers are low, a "Rescue Flip" can sometimes be activated for a 2nd opportunity.

2. Pachinko

Motivated by the standard Japanese arcade video game, the Pachinko benefit round includes a massive wall filled with physical pegs. The game host drops a puck from the top of the board, and it bounces arbitrarily down through the pegs until it lands in one of the multiplier zones at the bottom.

- If the puck arrive on a **"Double"** value, all multipliers at the bottom of the wall double, and the puck is dropped once again for even higher stakes.

3. Money Hunt

Cash Hunt is an interactive shooting gallery minigame. Players are provided with an enormous screen displaying 108 random multipliers hidden behind different signs (such as a cactus, a target, or a chef's hat).

- Gamers use an on-screen crosshair to objective and "shoot" their picked sign before the timer goes out.
- Once time ends, all symbols reveal their covert multipliers, and players receive the multiplier attached to their picked target.

4. Crazy Time

The crown jewel of the game is the Crazy Time bonus offer round. Players walk through a red door into a vibrant, virtual wonderland including a huge, 64-segment mega wheel.

- Before the wheel is spun, players must pick among 3 flappers: **Green, Blue, or Yellow**.
- The wheel is spun, and whichever multiplier the chosen flapper points to is granted to the player.
- Similar to Pachinko, this wheel includes **"Double"** and **"Triple"** sectors. If the flapper arrive on among these, the multipliers on the wheel increase, and the wheel is spun again-- potentially pressing payouts up to the game's optimum limit of **20,000 x**.

Key Strategies for Playing Crazy Time

While Crazy Time is basically a video game of chance powered by a Random Number Generator (RNG) and a physical wheel, players often adopt specific wagering strategies to handle their danger and extend their playtime.

Popular Betting Approaches

- **The Safe & Steady Strategy (Number Betting):**
 - Focus mostly on banking on numbers 1 and 2, while putting little hedge bets on reward rounds. This technique yields frequent, smaller sized wins and keeps the bankroll stable.
- **The Bonus Hunter Strategy:**
 - Place bets specifically on the 4 perk rounds (Coin Flip, Pachinko, Cash Hunt, and Crazy Time). This is a high-volatility method designed for players who want to experience the minigames as typically as possible, accepting that they might experience dry spells of non-bonus spins.
- **The Balanced Spread:**
 - Cover a mix of numbers and all four perk rounds proportionally. This guarantees that almost every spin of the wheel yields some kind of return or activates a feature.

Necessary Tips for Beginners

- **Set a Budget:** Decide on a set bankroll before logging in and never chase losses.
- **Understand RTP:** Keep in mind that various bets have somewhat various Return to Player percentages. Number bets generally offer a higher analytical RTP than perk bets, however benefit bets offer the excitement of huge multipliers.
- **Take pleasure in the Show:** Crazy Time is developed as entertainment first. Treat the possible earnings as a benefit to the interactive, game-show experience.

The success of Crazy Time comes down to Evolution Gaming's ability to integrate high production values with social gameplay. The live chat function allows gamers from around the world to commemorate wins together, producing a communal environment similar to a physical gambling establishment flooring.
