Wood siding necessities a graduated strategy. We wash lightly with a space-different purifier, not a one-size persistent wash. High power etches mushy grain and invitations untimely failure. We scrape to a enterprise part, feather with eighty to one hundred twenty grit, then spot ideal naked regions with an oil or alkyd bonding primer that blocks tannin bleed, especially on cedar and redwood. Over sound paint, an acrylic primer-surfacer stages minor checking and lays a uniform base. If the home has lead paint, we shift to EPA RRP lead-nontoxic practices, because of this containment, HEPA extraction, and specified clean down strategies.

Fiber cement and engineered wood have their quirks. Factory-primed boards range in good quality. We payment for chalk with a darkish rag. Metal surfaces, from railings to advertisement doorways, demand rust manage. We put off scale to naked brilliant steel where plausible, feather intact coatings, solvent wipe to eliminate oils, and use a rust changing primer on pitted parts. Then we construct movie thickness with a DTM acrylic or urethane rated for exterior publicity. Skimping on movie build is why metal fails early. We degree wet movie thickness at some point of program to be sure the dry movie thickness matches the spec on the records sheet.

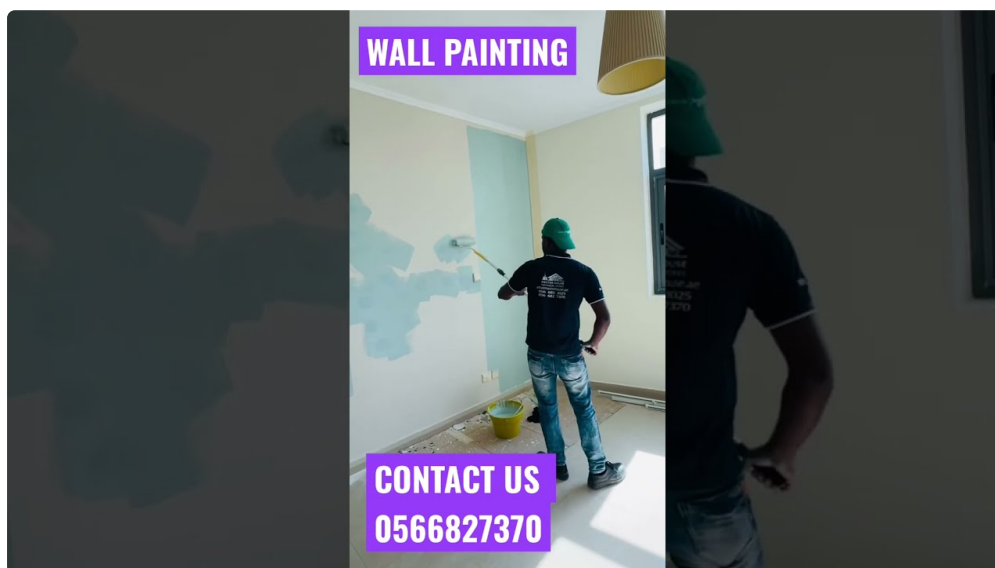
